Climate Emergency Working Party Report for Open Spaces

- 1. Working Party Members Cllr Denise Denis(chair), Cllr Sarah Powell, Cllr Isa Von Mesenkampff, Cllr S. Eden, Cllr G Folkard, Maddy Milnes, James Mochrie
- 2. First Meeting held on 16/1/23 set the **Aims for 2023** "Winning Hearts and Minds".
- 3. Agreed to ensure SMART **Strategies for 2023** (specific, measurable, achievable, relevant, timebound)
 - Focus on leaders i.e. Council staff, councillors and vehicles, processes and properties- Review WCC Sustainability report 2021-2022 and continue work to improve.
 - Wells City Council webpage dedicated to Climate Emergency and posts on Facebook.
 - Create a monkey survey (and use i-pads at public events, as well as publicise in Wells Journal and Wells Community Face Book) to find out where people are in their understanding and journey for climate emergency actions- to be launched before May and then to repeat in the autumn.
 - Concentrate on 3 public events- Coronation Event; WEN Open Day on 1 July at Portway Annexe; market stall for September or October to meet visitors as well as local people.
 - Decide on how to make the climate emergency message accessible, acceptable and memorable. Use of imagery and examples that touch people's hearts and win their minds. Be mindful of young people and effects of climate emergency trauma in messaging.
 - Promote Carbon footprint calculators.
- 4. Work forward on 5 areas defined by a paper produced by Wells City Council, Sustainable Wells, Project Factory, Somerset Climate Action Network in February 2020.
