18/16A REPORT FROM THE ARCHIVIST

The Archivist presented her report and answered questions. She drew members' attention to the Southover History Day and the Mayor's Remembrance project.

The Archivist reported on the Archives website project, she showed the dummy site prepared by volunteers, also the Museum website. She described the type of website and search facility she would like; to be loaded and operated by volunteers. Members asked questions and discussed the issues raised; it was suggested that funds could be set aside from the Committee's budget to provide a dedicated searchable website. Enquiries have been made with the City Council's website provider but it was agreed the options available are too costly; the extra capacity requested cannot be simply 'bolted on'.

In conclusion the Archivist was asked to take advice and then seek quotes i.r.o. £1,000 - £2,000 for a separate website with sufficient capacity.

It was agreed that for the present the existing files prepared by the volunteers can be released onto the current Museum website data base.
