18/60C **ELECTION OF MAYOR**

The outgoing Mayor called for nominations for Mayor.

Cllr Robbins nominated Cllr Wride, seconded by Cllr Gibson. There were no further nominations and Cllr Wride was unanimously elected.

Cllr North declared the election of the 645th Mayor of Wells and invested

Cllr Wride with the chain of office.

The mayoral party left the room for the exchange of robes and chain whilst

a short performance of classical music was given.

The Mayoral party returned to the platform.

She appointed her Mayoress, Miss Sarah Wride.

The former Mayor and Mayoress were presented with the city badge by the Father of the Council, Cllr Kennedy.
